**ONGOING PROJECTS**

1. **Spelling/Vocabulary** 10 new words a week; cumulative quizzes once a month (total: 5 quizzes)
  - *Purpose* – For students to accurately apply more sophisticated language skills in their writing
  - *Goal* – To expand the vocabulary knowledge of students
2. **Connections** – Art, Math, Music, P.E., Health, Science, Social Studies.
  - *Purpose* – For students to recognize the importance of writing and language arts skills outside of essays and basic classroom activities
  - *Goal* – To apply the writing skills students learn in the classroom to other academic disciplines
3. **Newspaper Exposure** – <http://www.newspaperforkids.com/> (*Children's BBC, Kids Science News, News by CNN*)
  - *Purpose*: To expose students to real-world events and news article writing.
  - *Goals*:
    - (1) To train kids to recognize parts of speech, main ideas, specific facts, and fact vs. opinion in news articles
    - (2) To gauge and improve students' understanding of factual news articles

**WRITING AND POETRY CONTESTS**

- Publish essays and winner's photo on website
  - Create and publish book of students' work
