MathEdgeCore Policy

Get Ready for Common Core (GK-5, Year-Round)

Our Common Core program is created to help students achieve day-to-day success and ace their common core tests in school. It teaches students to make sense of problems and persevere in solving them, to reason abstractly and quantitatively, to construct viable arguments and critique the reasoning of other, to attend to precision, to look for and make use of structure, and to look for and express regularity in repeated reasoning.

Registration Fee – Registration fee is required from all new students one time only if continuing through the years without breaks or up to 8 weeks summer break in a year is allowed.

Placement test fee – When a program requires assessment, the assessment fee (same as the registration fee) can replace the registration fee. Continuing students can challenge to skip a level by requesting reassessment. The reassessment fee is half of the assessment fee.

Tuition – Initial 3-month-per-year signup is required. After that, the next monthly payment is due on the 25th of the preceding month. If the payment is not received by the 5th of the new month, a 5% late fee will be charged. If the payment is not received by the 10^{th} of the new month, a 10% late fee will be charged. If starting not at the beginning of a month, partial month fee will be assessed.

Second Subject / Sibling Discount - 5% off after the full, published fees have been paid for the first subject or one child.

Class Unit – One-hour session consists of 55 minutes of instructional time and 5 minutes of transit.

Refund and Transfer Policy – No refunds will be granted. Full-month transfer to other MathEdge program is allowed after the initial 3-month signup requirement. Transferring to another MathEdgeCore subject, a new Initial 3-month-peryear signup requirement applies.

Class Makeup is allowed within the same week after minimum 48 hours advanced notice.

Student Performance - Quarterly report cards will be sent home with the students.

Homework – For MathCore, 5 pages homework (~ 15 mins a day for 5 days) are given after each class. Students are expected to bring the homework back for grading and review the next class.

Illness – Children who are sick should be kept at home and will not be permitted to stay in class.

Late Pickup – Please pick up your child within 10 minutes after the end of the class. A late pickup fee will be assessed at \$1/min after one warning. Payment must be made at the time of late pickup.

Students Leaving Without Their Parents - Students are not allowed to walk home, leave the center, or leave with anybody else without written notice from the student's parents beforehand.
